Conflict Minerals (3TG) Policy

1. **Purpose** : TGV SRAACL is committed to responsible and ethical sourcing and does not support the use of minerals that may contribute to armed conflict, human rights abuses, or illegal activities.
2. **Scope** : This policy applies to our procurement activities, suppliers, contractors and business partners involved in supplying raw materials, equipment, components and other materials to the Company.
3. **3TG Minerals** : The conflict minerals commonly referred to as 3TG are:- Tin / Tantalum / Tungsten / Gold - Based on our current assessment of our manufacturing process and raw-material requirements, 3TG minerals are not intentionally used as raw materials or ingredients in our chloro-alkali products.
4. **Responsible Sourcing**: The Company expects its suppliers and business partners to
 - ❖ Comply with applicable laws and regulations relating to responsible mineral sourcing.
 - ❖ Avoid sourcing minerals that directly or indirectly finance armed groups or contribute to serious human rights abuses.
 - ❖ Provide relevant information regarding the origin and responsible sourcing of 3TG, where applicable.
 - ❖ Cooperate with the Company in responding to customer or regulatory requests concerning conflict minerals.
 - ❖ Where 3TG may be present in purchased equipment, components or other materials, the Company will make reasonable efforts to obtain appropriate information from relevant suppliers.
5. **Supplier Requirements** :
 - ❖ The Company will request suppliers to confirm whether 3TG is contained in materials supplied to TG SRAACL and, where applicable, whether such minerals are responsibly sourced.
 - ❖ Suppliers are advised to maintain appropriate records and provide supporting information when reasonably requested.
6. **Risk Management** : If a potential conflict-minerals risk is identified in our supply chain, our company will assess the risk and take appropriate action, which may include obtaining additional information, engaging with the supplier, requiring corrective action, or considering alternative sources.
7. **Commitment**: TGV SRAACL is committed to conducting its business responsibly and to continuously improving the transparency and integrity of its supply chain.

This policy is reviewed periodically and updated whenever necessary, to reflect changes in our operations, supply chain or applicable requirements.
